Parent or Guardian Agreement

- A \$100 minimum Tuition Deposit is due with the Reservation Form
- Payments can be made at any time. The remaining balance of tuition payment is due in full by May 30, 2019.
- Tuition must be paid according to the payment schedule indicated above. A \$35 service charge is assessed on all returned checks.
- Fee for International applicants includes tuition, room and board, ground transportation from Washington DC, canteen fee, and accident and sickness insurance only.
- Fee for US applicants includes tuition, room and board, canteen fee, and accident and sickness insurance only. Airport pickups from Lynchburg or Roanoke VA are free. Round trip transport from Washington DC to the GYV campus is an add-on fee of \$150.
- Legacy reserves the right to cancel any program option if there is insufficient registration. In this unlikely event, payments will be refunded in total.

Refund Policies: If an applicant withdraws :

- 30 or more days before the beginning date of the program, payments will be refunded minus \$100.
- 15 – 29 days before the beginning date of the program: 50% of the tuition will be refunded
- 14 or fewer days before the beginning date of program: no refund will be made.
- For any cause after beginning the program, no refund will be made.

Withdrawals are confirmed when Legacy has received a withdrawal notification from the applicant or his/her family or sponsor.
